Representation of Victoria Selection Criteria

- 1 Polocrosse Victoria must in regard to all polocrosse teams to represent Victoria call for nominations for selection and publicise the closing date for nominations.
- 2 The closing date for any nominations will be decided by the Polocrosse Victoria Executive Committee and so far as is practicable should be well in advance of the time that the Selectors must name the successful team members in order to allow the Selectors sufficient opportunity to evaluate each and every nominee before selection is complete .
- 3 Polocrosse Victoria will provide each Selector with an updated list of the names of those persons who have complied with nomination requirements promptly after the closing date for nominations.
- 4 Any person making himself or herself available for selection in accordance with the nomination requirements must at the same time as providing his or her name nominate the horse or horses both by name and by detailed description (to the satisfaction of Polocrosse Victoria) that they intend to ride when selected. Players will be selected on one named horse only. If for any reason the selected player is unable or unwilling to ride the horse selected any change to the persons selected can only occur with the consent of the Selectors in their absolute discretion. The Selectors may agree to the selected player riding a different horse or may remove the selected player from the team and may select such other person as is then available (providing that substitute person has complied with selection requirements), in their absolute discretion

- 5 Reserve players must be selected from those persons complying with the nomination requirements and must be notified of their selection. Any person selected as a reserve player must accept or decline this position. In an emergency the Selectors may with the approval of Polocrosse Victoria select a person to replace an injured or ill person from those persons then available irrespective of whether the replacement person has complied with nomination requirements.

Reserve players will be notified at the same time

- 6 Polocrosse Victoria must determine guidelines and requirements for selection for Victorian teams and provide copies of the guidelines and requirements (as amended from time to time) to the Selectors for use in the course of selecting persons to represent Victoria.
- 7 The selection process will be chaired by a Polocrosse Victoria Executive Committee Member.
- 8 Polocrosse Victoria must be satisfied that each person nominating himself or herself for selection is eligible to play in the team that they have nominated for. Polocrosse Victoria may require any person who nominates himself or herself for selection to provide any documentary or other evidence which in Polocrosse Victoria's Executive Committee's opinion is necessary to demonstrate such eligibility. Until this requirement is satisfied the name of any person who has not satisfied Polocrosse Victoria as to their eligibility will not be provided to Selectors for consideration...
- 9 All Selectors are required where practicable, to discuss the selections either by meeting in person, or by conference call.
- 10 Official Notification of the teams as selected will be distributed by the Polocrosse Victoria Secretary.

Polocrosse Victoria may in its absolute discretion from time to time alter or amend these criteria and may make such further provisions and requirements as to selection criteria and procedures as it thinks fit.
